- 2. Inadequate crisis communication
- 3. Insufficient sensitivity for vulnerable social groups and lack of inclusive perspective in crisis management system
- 4. Insufficient knowledge, skills and mindset, both for citizens and generalist proffesionals, how to deal with crisis, prevent risks and activate numerous resources
